

The lay summary: This summary should be pitched to a broad audience, and explain the significance of the work in simple language (i.e., not just an extension of the abstract). The summary should not exceed one single-spaced page (2.5 cm margins), be written in 12-point font, and submitted as a pdf (please title the document: "last name HLGRA.pdf") to the chair of the HLGRA committee (see below) no later than midnight (EST) of 11 March 2018 (note, that this is prior to the abstract submission deadline for the JMIH). Summaries will be reviewed by the HLGRA selection committee. Those that meet all competition requirements and are deemed to be among the most competitive will be selected for inclusion in the competition. A maximum of 20 competitors will be included. Those selected for the competition will be notified within two weeks.
